Patterson Ewen

Paterson Ewen was an influential Canadian painter. Ewen was a founding member of the Non-figurative artist's association of Montréal, along with Claude Tousignant, Jean-Paul Mousseau, Guido Molinari, and Marcel Barbeau

One of Canada's most original artists, whose work was highly structured and expressive of emotion and mood. It addresses her ability to transpose Soviet symbolism and European techniques into a North American context and presents an artist who stated that Canada made her a painter. Clark's art is key to understanding the diversity of experience that contributed to the nation's visual arts.

Living Loving Local Egg Month



The humble egg. Around the world, different cultures share the egg as a common element in their creation stories. Since 3200BC eggs from various fowl have been a human food source. Today it is the chicken egg that is most commonly eaten, however duck, quail and goose eggs are sometimes available. Regardless of which fowl they originate from, all eggs at market must be graded. Eggs are an excellent source of fat, protein and essential nutrients and are an integral part of so many recipes, from scrambled eggs to omelets, quiche, mayonnaise, custards, cakes and soufflés.
