Verve Senior Living Acquires The Ravines in Ottawa

Community to receive \$20 million in upgrades over the next two years

NEPEAN, ON, Sept. 22, 2026 /CNW/ - Verve Senior Living has acquired The Ravines, a full continuum of care senior living community at 626 Prado Private in Ottawa's Citiplace neighbourhood. Verve will own and operate the community as Verve The Ravines, effective September 22, 2026.

Verve will invest \$20 million in The Ravines over the next two years, supporting improvements to the community and the resident experience as part of its long-term commitment to the property. The investment will support extensive upgrades throughout the community, including renovated suites, refreshed care floors, and reimagined dining and lobby spaces.

The Ravines comprises two connected buildings. One offers Lifestyle Apartments for independent seniors. The other offers Independent Living, Independent Supportive Living, Assisted Living and Memory Care. The buildings are joined internally, allowing residents to access different levels of support without leaving their community or the people they know. Respite stays and trial stays are also offered.

"We are very excited about The Ravines and what it represents for Verve," said Scott Quinney, President of Verve Senior Living. "We see an outstanding community with great people, a strong reputation, and tremendous potential. Our commitment is to invest in the building, invest in the resident experience, invest in our team members, and in the future of seniors living in the greater Ottawa and Nepean areas."
